## Get Up to Speed on the Scottish Executive's Response to the National Youth Work Consultation

The Scottish Executive in launching their response to the youth work consultation - Moving Forward: A Strategy for Improving Young People's Changes Through Youth Work - have sought to kick start the delivery of the strategy by establishing a **Year of Action on Youth Work**.

Some £8m has been set aside to support this with funds targeted at improving facilities; open youth work programmes and national organisations training.

In addition to the new funding other actions have been identified around work in schools; new Standards Council for the sector and developing more effective localised infrastructures.

This Seminar will have key inputs from YouthLink Scotland on the strategy and opportunities to discuss local implications for managers, policy makers and youth workers. With funding deadlines for the facilities and Opportunities Fund open programme (the 6th July and 3rd August respectively) there will be opportunities for first hand briefings on these funds being administered by YouthLink Scotland.

People are being asked to book places for either the afternoon or evening session. A buffet will be available post-afternoon session and pre-evening.
